

## Information Security Principle

Accordingly, SK Inc. establishes and declares an information protection policy that satisfies the following.

- ① It protects SK Inc.'s information assets from illegal access and leakage.
- ② It maintains confidentiality, integrity, and availability of SK Inc.'s information assets.
- ③ SK Inc. complies with the legal security requirements related to information protection.
- ④ All employees of SK Inc. should be able to recognize the importance of information protection and properly prevent, detect, and respond to accidents.
- ⑤ SK Inc. periodically analyzes, checks, and audits risks related to information protection.

SK Inc. invests the time and resources necessary to comply with these information protection policies, and organizes and operates an organization that manages information protection. The organization is responsible for establishing, maintaining, inspecting, and training security regulations, guidelines and procedures. However, information protection cannot be performed only by a specific management



organization, and above all, it requires the participation and responsibility of all employees. Therefore, all employees must recognize the importance of information protection and continue to be interested in understanding and complying with the declared policy.
